We are reminded by the Book of Maccabees that, "It is a good and holy thing to pray for the dead." It is a great work of charity to pray for the deceased and remember them by visiting a cemetery. Here a prayer you can use when visiting a cemetery:

A PRAYER FOR VISITING A CEMETERY

Eternal God, have mercy on all who are buried here. □ (In particular, we pray for N. and N.) □ Bring them into your kingdom of light and peace □ and let them share joy with you □ and with all your saints. □ We ask this through Christ our Lord. □ R. Amen.

Blessed are those who have died in the Lord; □ let them rest from their labors □ for their good deeds go with them.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord. R. And let perpetual light shine upon them.

May they rest in peace. R. Amen.

May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, □ through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

May our remembrance of our departed brothers and sister always remind us that in Christ Jesus, "all the ties of love and affection which unite us in life do not unravel with death."

Please be assured of my prayers especially for all who are deeply grieving the loss of a loved one at this time of year.
